The 4th International Workshop on Business Models for Mobile Platforms (<u>BMMP12</u>) will take place on 11 October 2012 in conjunction with the ICIN 2012 conference in Berlin.

The massive migration of data applications towards mobile platforms is leading to great opportunities but also strong challenges for mobile network operators, smartphone providers, mobile web companies, telecom vendors and application developers.
