ICIN 2010 – Abstracts Deadline Extended to Monday 4 May

Following the recent disruption to air travel the extended abstracts deadline for ICIN 2010 has been extended. Prospective authors now have until 4 May to submit their extended abstracts through the EDAS (<http://edas.info>) manuscript registration system. Extended abstracts should be submitted electronically through EDAS at <http://edas.info/N8600>.

ICIN conferences address the interplay between web and telecom technologies and services. ICIN 2010 will focus on new applications formed by weaving together emerging network capabilities, computational power, network and customer data, and content in valuable new and different patterns.

ICIN 2010 has been **approved by the IEEE Communications Society** for technical co-sponsorship.

ICIN 2010 extended abstracts are invited for three presentation categories:

1. **Technical Paper Sessions** – the core of ICIN, constituting at least 80% of the programme
2. **Work in Progress Sessions** – shorter contributions that report on work still in progress at the time of submission of the extended abstract
3. **Demonstration Sessions** – 'enhanced poster sessions' with the ability to present multimedia demonstrations
